

Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy discloses the privacy practices for percellstthomass.com and applies solely to information collected by this website. We have created this privacy statement in order to demonstrate our firm and continuing commitment to the privacy of personal information provided by those visiting and interacting with this website. We hold the privacy of your personal information in the highest regard. The following discloses our information gathering and dissemination practices for this website.

We recognize the importance of protecting your privacy and our policy is designed to assist you in understanding how we collect, use, and safeguard the personal information you provide to us and to assist you in making informed decisions when using our site. What Information Do We Collect?

How Do We Use the Information That You Provide to Us?

Personal information is used for presenting the website and its contents, providing information and offers for products, services, subscriptions, and contracts between you and the website, administering business activities, and customer service.

Disclosure Of Your Information

As a general rule, we do not sell, rent, lease or otherwise transfer any information collected whether automatically or through your voluntary action.

Personal information to our subsidiaries and service providers might be shared solely for the purpose of providing our services to you.

Personal information to a third party, including a lawyer or collection agency, when necessary to enforce terms of service or other agreements between you and the website.

We may provide your information to any successor in interest in the event of a merger, divestiture, restructuring, reorganization, dissolution, or other sale or transfer of some or all of the Company's assets and/or business.

Personal information might be disclosed when we are legally compelled to do so, when, in good faith, it is believed to be legally required for our legal protection or when compelled by a court or other governmental entity to do so.

What Are Cookies?

A cookie is a very small text document, which often includes an anonymous unique identifier. When a website is accessed, that site's computer asks your computer for permission to store this file in a part of your hard drive specifically designated for cookies. Each website can send its own cookie to your browser if your browser's preferences allow it, but (to protect your privacy) your browser only permits a Website to access the cookies it has already sent to you, not the cookies sent to you by other sites. Browsers are usually set to accept cookies. However, if you would prefer not to receive cookies, you may alter the configuration of your browser to refuse cookies. The Company reserves the right to use technological equivalents of cookies, including social media pixels. These pixels allow social media sites to track visitors to outside websites so as to tailor advertising messages users see while visiting that social media website. The Company reserves the right to use these pixels in compliance with the policies of the various social media sites.

IP Addresses

IP addresses are used by your computer every time you are connected to the Internet. Your IP address is a number that is used by computers on the network to identify your computer. IP addresses are automatically collected by our web server as part of demographic and profile data known as traffic data so that data (such as the Web pages you request) can be sent to you.

Other Websites Linked to Our Website

We are not responsible for the practices employed by websites linked to or from our website or the information or content contained therein. Your Consent

By using our website you consent to our collection and use of your personal information as described in this Privacy Policy. We reserve the right to amend this Privacy Policy at any time with or without notice.

Our Commitment To Data Security

Your information will be stored and processed on our computers in the United States. The laws on holding personal data in the United States might be less stringent than the laws of other countries. To prevent unauthorized access, maintain data accuracy, and ensure the correct use of information, we have put in place appropriate physical, electronic, and managerial procedures to safeguard and secure the information we collect online.

Choice/Opt-In/Opt-Out

In compliance with the CAN-SPAM Act, all e-mails sent from our organization will clearly state who the e-mail is from and provide clear information on how to contact the sender. In addition, all e-mail messages will also contain concise information on how to remove yourself from our mailing list so that you receive no further e-mail communication from us.

Our emails provide users the opportunity to opt-out of receiving communications from us by reading the unsubscribe instructions located at the bottom of any e-mail they receive from us at anytime.

Users who no longer wish to receive our newsletter or promotional materials may opt-out of receiving these communications by clicking on the unsubscribe link in the e-mail. After unsubscribing we will discontinue sending the particular messages as soon as technically feasible.

California Online Privacy Protection Act

Minor Children

Visitors' GDPR Rights
